

## DO YOU KNOW WHERE THIS GRAVE IS IN BALLINROBE SECTION B?



THIS GRAVE ABOVE IS MARTIN FEENEY, TAKEN AROUND 1970, PLOT 241 SECTION B AND IN BACKGROUND YOU CAN SEE WHAT LOOKS LIKE THE SLAB MARKING THE GRAVE WE ARE LOOKING FOR.

This is Bridget Philbin (nee Feeny) by her mum and dad's grave in 1950

Our dad, Thomas Martin Philbin, promised his mum, pictured above, that he would erect a stone on her mother and father's grave in Ballinrobe. She died in 1985 a week before we were all going to go to Ireland. Dad himself is now 87 and wants to honour his promise. We are coming over September 2014

We have done as much research as we can and have put this together in the hope someone can help us to identify

where the plot is so we can arrange to erect a stone on the correct plot. The picture bottom right, kindly taken for us by Dympna Joyce, shows the back wall today, which is two rows behind where the Martin Feeny grave is and we think it could be likely that the one of the empty plots could be what we are searching for.

The plot numbers that look empty on map of Ballinrobe graveyard are:

301,302, 304,305 and also 264 - 268 we think plots 301 - 5 look likely. There is no record of a Winnifred and Martin Feeny grave on Findagrave.com. We think because they were too poor to have a stone erected.
